The Noeline Clark Foundation charitable trust was established by Noeline Clark who was a Divisional Principal at Burnside High School from 1960 to 1976. Since the year 2000, The Trust has awarded 26 scholarships to Burnside High School students to help pay tuitions fees for undergraduate study at the University of Canterbury.

Initially the Trust gave two \$1,000.00 scholarships each year. In 2008 the late Richard Clark, Ms Clark's brother, vested further funds into the Trust on his passing and that enabled the Trustees to increase scholarships to two \$5,000.00 annual awards. It is the wishes of Ms Clark that the Foundation continues indefinitely and the Trustees are working hard to ensure that is possible.
